Three hundred and sixty eight items were collected, and donations through this program were distributed to 77 children at the Boykin Headstart Program, Rottschafer's Day Care in Brewton, and Small Wonder Day Care in East Brewton. The Small Wonder Day Care often lets JDCC Nursing students observe children for class assignments on children's growth and development. The Nursing Department also took some of the larger sizes which were donated to the Sacred Heart Hospital, School Age and Adolescent Unit in Pensacola.
